Session One: Weekend Overnight Camp (Grades 6-12)

- Friday, June 24-Sunday, June 26
- Cost: \$55

- Cost: \$95
- Camp includes 3 days of PA/CIT Training and then girls will put their new skills to use as official PA/CITs at Brownie/Junior Camp Weekend (July 16-17)

Session Three: CIT Certification and Extended Camp Experience (Grades 9-12)

- Friday, June 24-Sunday, July 3
- Cost: \$155
- Camp includes traditional camp activities (June 24-26), an off-site excursion and Take Action Project (June 29-July 3), and a training to become CIT certified with hands-on experience as official CITs during GSSI's Brownie/Junior Camp Weekend (July 16-17)
