COVID-19 Expectations

Safety is a cornerstone of Girl Scouting and we will continue to put the health and safety of our campers and volunteers first throughout the summer camp season. Girl Scouts is regularly monitoring COVID-19 updates and recommendations from the Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA), the American Camp Association (ACA), and the state and local authorities, and will continue to adjust guidelines and processes with the goal of providing a safe and fun outdoor experience. All of GSSI's 2021 summer camp programs, including day and overnight camps, will follow the guidelines and processes outlined in the *Day Camp and COVID Expectations* document included with this registration letter.

Girl Scouts will continue to monitor the information around COVID-19 and will provide updates in order to run summer camp programs with the most current public health information in mind. Health & Safety

A nurse or certified First Aider will be on duty at all times. GSUSA Health and Safety Standards will be observed. The Camp First Aider will dispense all medications according to the parent's written directions. **Medication MUST be sent in the original container and must be turned into the Camp First Aider.** Use insect repellent before coming to camp.

Volunteers Needed!

Unit Staff, Helping Hands, Craft, Lifeguard, Nurse, Overnight, Set-up, Tear Down and more volunteers are needed. Please complete the Adult Volunteer form. You will be contacted with further information. **Adult volunteers who help all week (or 3 days for Daisy & Brownies) will get \$25 off one daughter's camp fee and receive a free t-shirt.** For Cadette and Teen volunteers, see "Cadette/Teen Volunteers" on this page. Cadette and Teen registration DOES NOT qualify to receive \$25 off a sibling's camp fee. Overnight (Juniors & Cadettes)

Juniors and Cadettes (including Cadette volunteers) have an overnight Friday night. They will be sleeping in tents and kept in "pods" of the same girls in order to take COVID-19 precautions. Space may be limited. If your daughter does not wish to participate in the overnight, she will be released to go home at 9:00pm. She may return to camp the next morning at 8:00am.

Cadette Adventure Day

On Friday of camp, Cadettes will go ziplining at Squire Boone Caverns near Corydon. Teen and adult volunteers are welcome to attend, too. The cost per person is \$50 (including adults). This is in addition to the camp fee for scouts and teen volunteers. Cadette campers not wishing to zipline may opt out and will follow the Junior schedule for Friday.

Cadette/Teen Volunteer Option

Please complete the Volunteer Registration Form AND the Cadette/Teen Volunteer Form for any scout wishing to volunteer.

Cadettes may choose to volunteer during Day Camp. There is a \$25 fee for Cadette volunteers, which includes meals and supplies on Friday and Saturday.

Teen Girl Scouts who have aged out of camp may volunteer at no cost Monday-Wednesday only. They may opt into the overnight for \$25 and ziplining for \$50. All volunteers receive a shirt if registration is received on time.

Cadettes and Teen scouts who volunteer at Day Camp qualify for the Service to Girl Scouts award. The Day Camp Director will submit the needed paperwork for the award. However, the scout's leader will be responsible for ordering the pin.

A confirmation letter with more information will be sent to you by email or mail about 1-2 weeks before camp starts.

Scouterships

Financial help of up to half the camp fee is available. Contact your daughter's Troop Leader for the Scoutership application. Complete the form and return it to the Troop Leader before the scoutership deadline listed under *Dates to Remember*. Leaders, Scoutership applications must be received in the GSSI Council office no later than May 25.

Refunds

If written cancellation is received before May 25, the entire camp fee will be refunded and Cookie Dough will be credited back. **No refunds after June 1.** Exceptions may be made for COVID-19.
