

Girl Scouts of Southwest Indiana COVID-19 Plan **UPDATE October 2020**

This chart is created as an “at-a-glance guide” for Girl Scouts of Southwest Indiana activities only and may be subject to change at any time based on government and GSUSA expectations.

IMPORTANT NOTE: Governor Holcomb’s recent announcement regarding Indiana’s shift into its final stage of re-opening does NOT immediately change Girl Scout COVID restrictions. Per GSUSA, we must be safely past the final phase of opening to make any additional internal regulation changes to Girl Scout activities. Please stay posted, GSSI will review changes to its [Back to Troop COVID Recommendations and Guidance](#) at the end of October/beginning of November. Below is an at-a-glance view of our current expectations and changes to come.

REMINDER: If participating in Girl Scout (in-person) activities, all individuals (members/non-members) MUST have a [COVID Waiver](#) completed and on file with troop leader.

Troop Outings	Indiana only, no carpooling	<i>If activity is outside of Indiana, group is solely responsible for reviewing and following all state guidelines (some states/areas may be restricted based on COVID hot spots).</i>
Troop Travel	Indiana only, no carpooling	<i>If activity is outside of Indiana, group is solely responsible for reviewing and following all state guidelines (some states/areas may be restricted based on COVID hot spots).</i>
Overnights	Individual or family sleeping only	<i>Permitted with special guidelines in place</i>
Troop Camping	Individual or family sleeping only	<i>Permitted with special guidelines in place</i>
*Large Events (100+)	Permitted with Restrictions, contact GSSI	<i>Permitted with additional guidelines, contact GSSI</i>
*Money-Earning Activities	Permitted with Restrictions, contact GSSI	<i>Permitted with additional guidelines, contact GSSI</i>
Resident Camp	X	TBD
*Day Camp (With Restrictions)	Permitted with Restrictions, contact GSSI	<i>Permitted with additional guidelines, contact GSSI</i>
Volunteer Meetings/Trainings	Permitted (Outdoor spaces and small group interactions recommended)	<i>Permitted, small group interactions recommended</i>
Facial Coverings	Required if social distancing is difficult	<i>Recommended if social distancing is difficult</i>

NOTE: Restrictions may change in each county, based on government regulations. GSSI will reassess the state of the pandemic at the end of October/beginning of November to ensure we are safely functioning in the final stage, per GSUSA guidelines.
