



Girl Scout Bronze Award Guidelines

For girls in grades 4th-5th grade, earned as a team with other Girl Scout Juniors. Adult Lead Volunteer should complete this form with the girls. Submit form by March 1 to be recognized at the spring awards ceremony. Pins are purchased by troop or individual girl through the council shop 812-421-4970, support@girlscouts-gssi.org.

1. Girls complete one Junior-level journey (including the associated Take Action Project and Journey Award.)
2. Girls review the [Girl Scout Bronze Award – Girl Guide](#).
3. Adult volunteers review the [Girl Scout Bronze Award – Adult Guide](#).
4. Adult volunteers view [GSSI's Girl Scout Bronze Award online module](#).
5. Girls plan a Bronze Award Project. The adult volunteer approves the plan.
6. Girls implement and complete the project (under the supervision of adults, but girls should be the leaders in the project).
7. When girls have finished the project, the adult volunteer assists the girls while, as a group, they complete the [Girl Scout Bronze Award Final Report](#). Call or stop in to council shop to order Bronze Award pins.
8. Girls are recognized and celebrated by Girl Scouts of Southwest Indiana.
