Council Cookie Booth Lotteries

We will hold cookie booth lotteries in December and January. Cookie volunteers will be notified through Smart Cookies of when lotteries will take place and if additional lotteries are added, so please be sure to regularly check your email for updates.

The first four lotteries will be:

- Lowe's East Side: Friday, December 10 at 9:00 AM CST–Sunday, December 12 at 5:00 PM CST
- Sam's Club: Monday, December 13 at 9:00 AM CST–Wednesday, December 15 at 5:00 PM CST
- Walmart East Evansville: Thursday, December 16 at 9:00 AM CST– Saturday, December 18 at 5:00 PM CST
- Walmart West Evansville: Sunday, December 19 at 9:00 AM CST–Tuesday, December 21 at 5:00 PM CST

Lotteries will be drawn at 7:00 PM CST on ending date and troops selected will receive an email from ABC Smart Cookies. Any remaining council lottery locations will become first come, first serve in January after all lotteries have concluded. Cookie volunteers will receive an email when these times become available.

We are still working to confirm with the Newburgh and Evansville First Avenue Walmart locations whether they will be council lotteries or if troops can call directly. Please DO NOT call these stores at this time.

In 2022, GSUSA is seeking ten new members to join the Girl Advisory Board to Girl Scouts of the USA (GSUSA). The Girl Advisory Board to GSUSA works with the Girl Scout national office on key projects and initiatives aligned to the national strategy and provides critical customer insight and innovative ideas to serve girls in the 21st Century. Members of the Girl Advisory Board will make recommendations, contribute to key initiatives, and influence decision-making processes at our national office. Girls gain experience creating change in a national nonprofit organization, receive hands-on training, professional development opportunities and skill development.

Girl Advisory Board members serve for two years or until their high school graduation, whichever comes first.

Application Qualifications

- Enrolled in 7th 11th grade for fall 2022.
- Registered as a Girl Scout at the time of application (if accepted, girls must renew their membership by the start of the new membership year, October 1).
- Genuine interest in taking on a leadership role on the national level of Girl Scouts.
- Ability to communicate with your peers and with adults.
- Ability to work well independently and on a team.
- Committed to using technology as a platform for research and communication.
