From September 12-September 30, every GSSI shop purchase of \$60+ will receive a \$10 coupon. The coupons are valid on shop purchases of \$25+ from October 1- November 30, 2022. Each customer may earn a maximum of three coupons, and multiple coupons may be earned on one purchase. For example:

- \$60-\$119.99 = 1 coupon
- \$120-\$159.99 = 2 coupons
- \$160 + = 3 coupons

To redeem coupons, the original purchase receipt must be attached. The promotion is only valid on purchases made through the GSSI shop; not applicable to GSUSA online purchases.
