

# Planning & Funding your Troop Year

## Step One: Plan Your Adventures

### Ask your troop:

- What activities or adventures do the girls want to try?
- What skills or badges do they want to earn?
- Are there any big goals (e.g., trips, events) they hope to achieve?

## Next Steps

### GSSI Recommends:

- Choosing 2-4 badges or 1 journey to complete.
- Including at least 1 activity from each of the 4 pillars (Entrepreneurship, STEM, Life Skills, Outdoors).
- Planning field trips or outings.
- Considering community service or Take Action Projects.

## Step Two: Determine Expenses

### After completing your plan for the year, consider the following:

- Estimate the cost of each activity, including event registration/admission, supplies, and badges/patches.
- When planning outings & trips, consider the cost of travel, meals, and lodging.
- Determine if you can allocate any of your current troop funds for these expenses.

Utilize the Troop Budget Planner on the next page to determine the total funds needed for the year.

## Step Three: Set Funding Goals

**Troops are encouraged to participate in the Girl Scout Cookie program to fund their year.** Consider the following ways to increase proceeds:

- Opt-out of recognitions with (Juniors and above).
- Encourage girls to select Cookie Dough as a recognition to pay for their activities.
- Work to set individual goals to reach higher proceed and bonus levels.
