Appointment and Support

Service Unit Day Camp Directors are appointed by Girl Scouts of Southwest Indiana (GSSI) staff and are asked to fulfill a one-year renewable term. You will work directly with the GSSI Girl Experience Specialist and your Service Unit Outdoor Instructor to ensure safe, quality outdoor programming. Additional staff members are also available for direct assistance as needed.

You will increase your knowledge of Girl Scout badges and journeys while learning best event planning and evaluation practices.
