Appointment and Support

Service Unit Outdoor Instructors are appointed by GSSI staff and are asked to fulfill a one-year renewable term. You will work directly with the Service Unit Day Camp Director, GSSI Girl Experience Specialist, and the GSSI Volunteer Support & Training Manager to ensure safe, quality outdoor programming throughout the year. Additional staff members are also available for direct assistance as needed.
