

Teen Mentoring Awards Guide

Steps to earn Teen Mentoring Awards are found in age-appropriate Handbooks, Girls Guides to Girl Scouting and on the Council Application.

Mentoring Award	Grade Level	Steps
Junior Aide	Junior	 Work with Daisies or Brownies over three (3) activity sessions. More information can be found in the Junior Handbook.
Leader-in- Action (LIA)	Cadette	 Assist a Brownie troop on any of their Journeys. Complete requirements can be found in the Brownie Journey Adult Guides.
Program Aide	Cadette	 Earn one LIA Award Complete Program Aide Core Training Work directly with younger girls (DA-JR) over 6 activity sessions - approximately 20 hours including session prep work. Submit GSSI's Program Aide Mentoring Award Application
Volunteer-in- Training (VIT)	Senior (10 th grade) or Ambassador	 Find an adult mentor volunteer who will work with you for a 3-6 month period with a group of younger girls Complete Volunteer-in-Training Leadership Course Create and implement a program (DA-CD) based on a Journey or badge that last 4 or more sessions. Submit GSSI's Volunteer-in-Training Mentoring Award Application
Counselor-in- Training I (CIT I)	Senior or Ambassador	 Complete Counselor-in-Training I Leadership Course Complete GSSI's Fire Building and Basic Outdoor Cooking Courses Work with younger girls (DA-CD) over the course of a multi-day camp session (Resident or Day) – approximately 40 hours including session prep work Submit GSSI's Counselor-in-Training I Mentoring Award Application
Counselor-in- Training II (CIT II)	Ambassador	 Earn CIT I Award Complete Counselor-in-Training II Leadership Course Work with younger girls (DA-CD) over the course of one camp session (Resident or Day) while focusing your skills in one specific area – approximately 8 hours including session prep work Submit GSSI's Counselor-in-Training II Mentoring Award Application
