It's a new fiscal year for Girl Scouts of Southwest Indiana, which is always a time that I reflect on the previous year and the impact that each donor made within the movement. This past year, you empowered 66 girls earn their Highest Awards—Gold, Silver, or Bronze, championed 270 girls to participate in the Girl Scout Leadership Experience in 12 different Title I schools, helped host 12 different camping experiences for 465 girls, and ensured over 1,200 girls continue to be an entrepreneur in our cookie program.

Donor Impact Goals


- \$70,000 to financial assistance to families in need
